- 3. The maximum load of this unit is 200lbs/90.9kg. It fits 75"-90" LCD. DO NOT exceed the maximum permissible weight of the unit.
- 4. DO NOT make non-factory approved modifications. DO NOT use the unit outside of its factory approved purpose.
- 5. The unit contains sliding parts and electronic components. For safety's sake, please be careful in using.
- 6. We DECLARE that we CAN NOT be liable for damage or injury caused by improper mounting, incorrect assembly or inappropriate use.
- 7. Death or serious injury may occur when children climb on audio and/or video equipment furniture. A remote control or toys placed on the furnishing may encourage a child to climb on the furnishing and as a result the furnishing may tip over on to the child.

Never allow children to climb, stand, hang, or play on any part of TV or TV cart.


Use tip over restraint or anchor stand to wall.


Use of tip over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tip over.


- 11. Choking Hazard Warning
 - Small parts are not for children under 3 years. Adult supervision is required. Keep children away from the assembly hardware. Small pieces may result in choking if swallowed.
- 12. Do not expose to direct sunlight or hot surface. Do not place the product close to heat elements, as well as near an open fire.
- 13. Keep all electrical components away from liquids.
- 14. The TV should be in the center position, to avoid unbalanced placement and damage to items.
- 15. When the product is running, please pay attention to whether there are obstacles around it to avoid collision causing losses or casualties.
- 16. When the product is raised, please pay attention to the length of the power line during operation to prevent damaging wires causing leakage of electricity, electric shock and other potential safety hazards.
- 17. DO NOT place the bracket on slopes or non-parallel surfaces, avoid sloping, causing damage to items or injury to people.
- 18. When turning on the caster switch to move the stand, please move it slowly and do not use excessive force. When moving to the designated position, be sure to lock the casters to prevent the casters from sliding and causing the stand to move, causing losses or casualties.
- 19. Do not use unsafe old power line to avoid accidents.
- 20. Please hold the plug to pull out, do not pull out the plug with the power cable directly.














2.Legs and Uprights Assembly




3. Tray and Power Crossbar Assembly




4. Pillar and Power Crossbar Assembly




5.TV Plate Installation




6.VESA Mounting Patterns



7.VESA Rails and TV Assembly




8. Touch Panel Instruction




Please initialize the product under no-load condition before hanging the TV set, after powering on 100-240 V, long press the \mathbb{R} key on the touch panel to initialize the settings (see below), when the number on the touch panel reads "1750", the product can be used normally.

| Initialization settings | Press and hold touch-pad \mathbb{R} , the display appears""on blinking, entering the initialization procedure, until the number on the touch panel reads "1750". At this point, the bracket is at the upper start point and initialization is completed. |

| Child lock settings (lock/open) | Press and hold Lock light appears red, the touch panel gets locked. Press and hold Lock light appears green, the touch panel turns unlocked. |
| Go upward | Press and hold 🛆 , The bracket rises at a constant speed. Release the button to stop operation. |
| Go down | Press and hold , The bracket goes down at a constant speed. Release the button to stop operation |



1. How to match remote control with touch control panel

- a. Make sure the stand is not powered on.
- b. Press and hold the
 button on the remote control until the signal light flashes. Power on the stand while pressing and holding the button, and release the button until the signal light on the remote control goes out. At this time, the remote control and the touch panel are successfully matched.

- 1. Lithium battery specification: CR2032. Lithium battery is not included in the product, due to the restrictions on shipping from certain countries and regions.
- 2. Do not disassemble the remote control by non-professionals, otherwise, it may cause the remote control to malfunction.
