Graphic Size \ Trim Line

The "Graphic Size" on the template is the total area of the graphic that is printed and where the graphic will be trimmed to.
Total size 290mm x 887.5mm

Safe Area

The "Safe Area" on the template is the front viewable area that will be clearly visible after the graphic is erected.
Keep all text and important images within this area.
