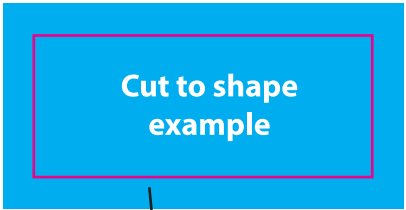


Graphic Size \ Trim Line

Your image can be any size as long as it does not exceed the max graphic size of 350x550mm. Please ensure that text is kept at least 10mm from the edge.  
If you have not purchased a "Cut to Shape" item your graphic will be square cut to its margins.

Cut to Shape

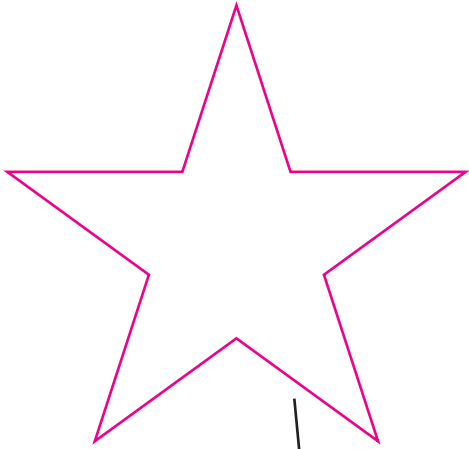
After you have completed your design and you have purchased a “cut to shape” product you can then trace a line around the area you wish to have cut to shape. Please ensure that the cut line is placed on the cut layer of this template. You can see an example of a cut to shape graphic in the “C2Sgraphic” layer in this template.



Magenta line is the cut line.  
Your graphic needs to bleed past the cut line approx. 5mm

Frosted Vinyl

If you have purchased a “cut to shape frosted vinyl” product. Please supply a vectored line drawing of your graphic on the “cut layer” of this template. Please ensure all shapes to be cut are no smaller than 2mm in width\weight as any vinyl cut smaller than this will have an increased chance of peeling from the acrylic substrate.  
You can see an example of a frosted cut graphic in the “C2SFrost” layer in this template.



Magenta line is the cut line.  
The Frosted vinyl only requires the cut line

FILE REQUIREMENTS:

- CMYK
- Minimum 150 DPI
- Convert all fonts to outlines
- Embed any linked images

Before saving, please turn off or delete the “Template” layer.
